Dear students,

Welcome to the School of Nursing! We are so excited that you will be a part of the MCPHS community! A note regarding your textbooks:

- 1. It is required that you purchase your resources in advance of orientation, at least by a week, as it takes time to ship books to you (if purchasing in December, holiday mailing slows things down even further)
- 2. Using the 2 links provided will give you the biggest discount. They also provide free shipping for your book(s).
- 3. For Boston students: Please chose the correct link specific to the Boston campus for Evolve, The F. A. Davis link is for all campuses. The Evolve package is tailored to faculty requirements on the Boston campus and will not include physical copies. The F. A. Davis link is for physical copies as required by your faculty.
- 4. For Worcester and Manchester students. There are two packages for Evolve and one for F. A. Davis. The F. A. Davis provides you physical copies as required by your course for all campuses. The other links for Evolve provides you with resources you will need and are specific to your campus. You have the choice of purchasing ebooks or physical books. Regardless of the option you choose, you will receive a physical copy of the lab manual if you are in the Manchester or Worcester programs as it is required for NUR 245, your Health Assessment class.
- 5. There are a couple of things that you are purchasing that provide access to electronic platforms we use during your program. Think of them like a lock. When classes begin, your faculty will provide you with a code that works like a key.
- 6. When creating an account, please use your full legal name and your MCPHS email.

Frequently Asked Questions

Can I use an older edition of the book?

This is not recommended in the 200 level. The reason why, is because you need access to electronic platforms, and in some cases, specific books. To purchase these programs separately, will drive up your cost, therefore, we have partnered with the publishers to give you the best price for all of your resources.

Can I wait to purchase everything when classes begin?

We do not recommend this. Purchasing things last minute usually results in some added stress as we help students access their programs. Additionally, you will be without some of the books you need for a period of time while they ship. Please purchase your resources prior to orientation.

Can I sell books when I am done?

Some of the books are used in multiple levels throughout the program, please refer to the booklist.

What are the other books/products I am seeing on the list that are not included in one of those two codes? Do I need to purchase them?

Yes and no. Those are books/products that are either required or recommended. Many have links to free ebooks through our library, but some you will have to purchase, such as safeMedicate (another program). Recommended are optional, not mandatory for your courses.
